HIGH SCHOOL SENIOR SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

Scholarships will be awarded to students who are entering a 4 or 5-year degree program in Accounting or Finance at an accredited college or university in the state of Montana. Students from the following Montana counties are eligible: Yellowstone, Stillwater and Carbon Counties. Factors for determining scholarship recipient include leadership, community service, extra curricular activities, financial need, Grade Point Average (GPA), and essay.

High School students must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 on a seven-semester transcript.

One (1) \$500 scholarship is available for graduating seniors.

Applications for scholarships must be accompanied with:

- Three personal letters of reference. Two should come from someone other than a relative, i.e., teacher, minister, employer, counselor, coach, etc.
- 100 - 300 word essay addressing reasons for requesting this scholarship
- Most recent transcript

If additional space is needed for any area of the application, a clearly labeled additional sheet may be attached.

The Scholarship Committee of the Billings Chapter of the American Society of Women Accountants will select the scholarship recipient. In addition, input may be sought from high school counselors or others where applicable.

This scholarship will be sent directly to the Financial Aid Office to assist with tuition, fees, and books. It is the scholarship recipient's responsibility to provide us with the address of the Financial Aid Office. The entire scholarship amount will be sent for the first semester.

Applications and other required information must be received by April 15, 2008. Scholarship recipient will be notified by May 1, 2008.
